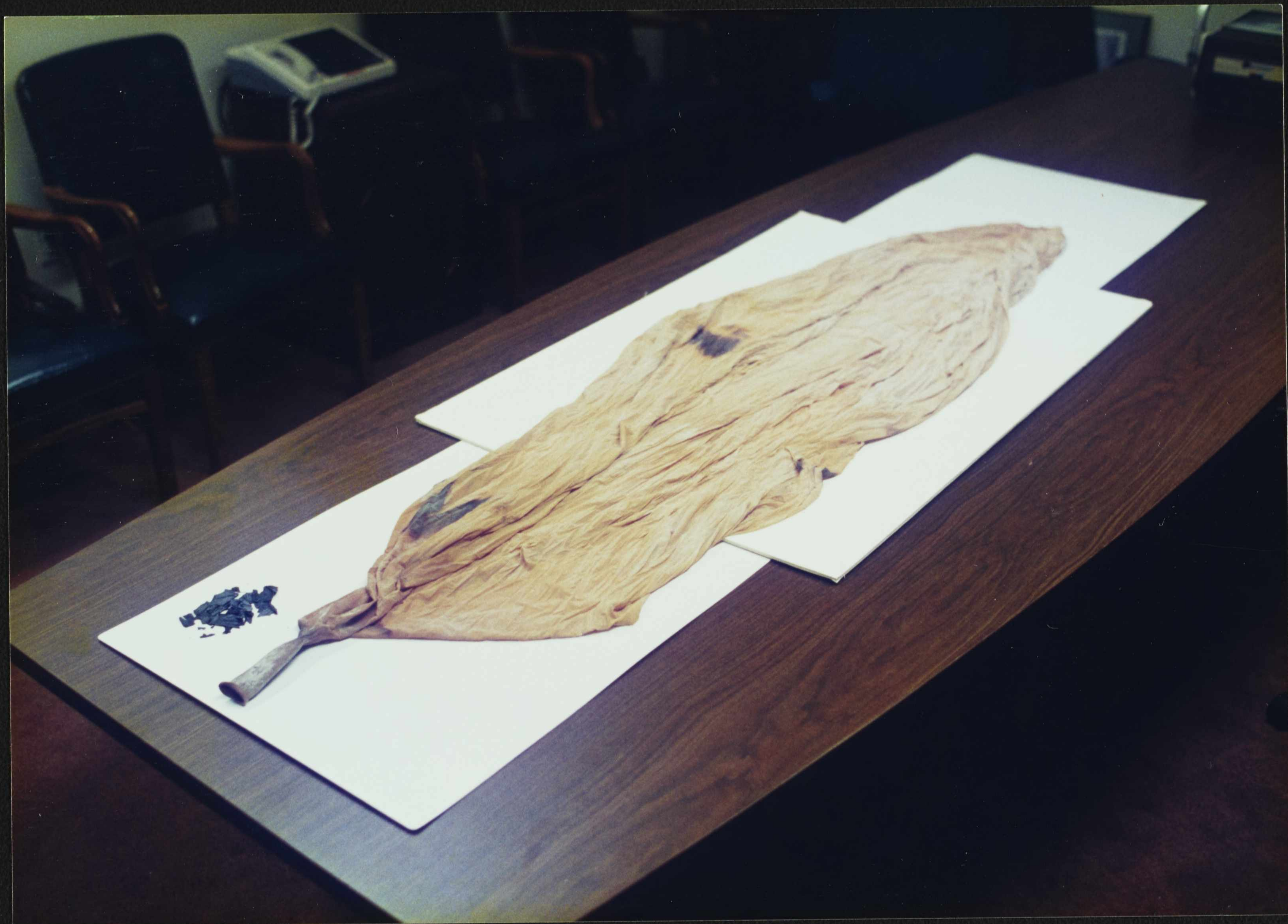
and hard evidence. The stories are of mysterious and unfamiliar debris that was quickly whisked away from their clutches without as much as an explanation. Many interviewed were indeed members of the elite, atomic 509th Bomb Group and possessed security clearances of the highest order, however, they did not have the other fundamental component necessary to obtain the highly classified MOGUL information --- **the need to know**. There is no doubt that these individuals were left with unanswered questions; the explanations not of extraterrestrial visitation and "cosmic conspiracy" but of the rather earthly and less sensational variety where an honest but unwitting group of uncleared persons, for a short period of time, comes in contact with highly classified information. 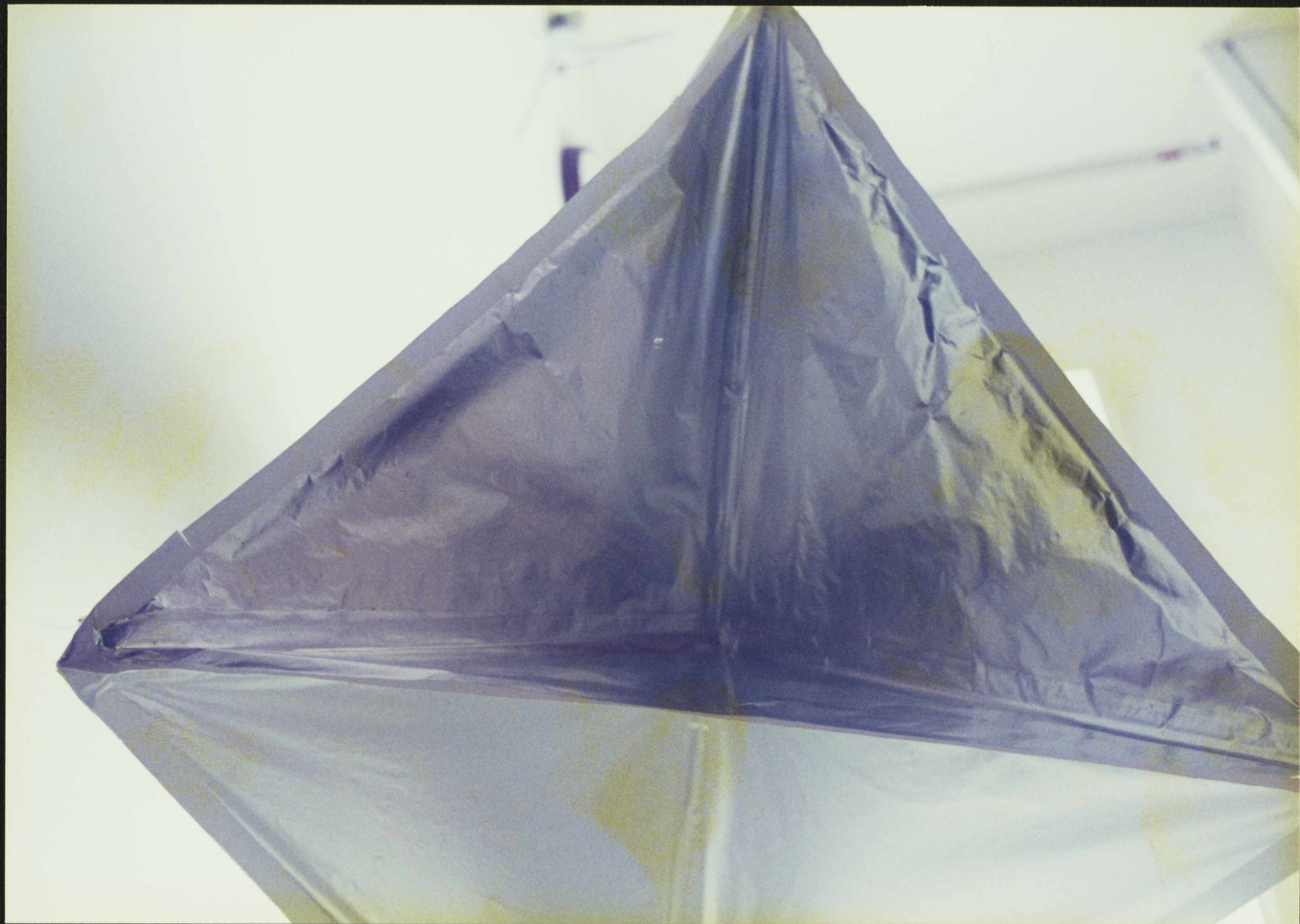


































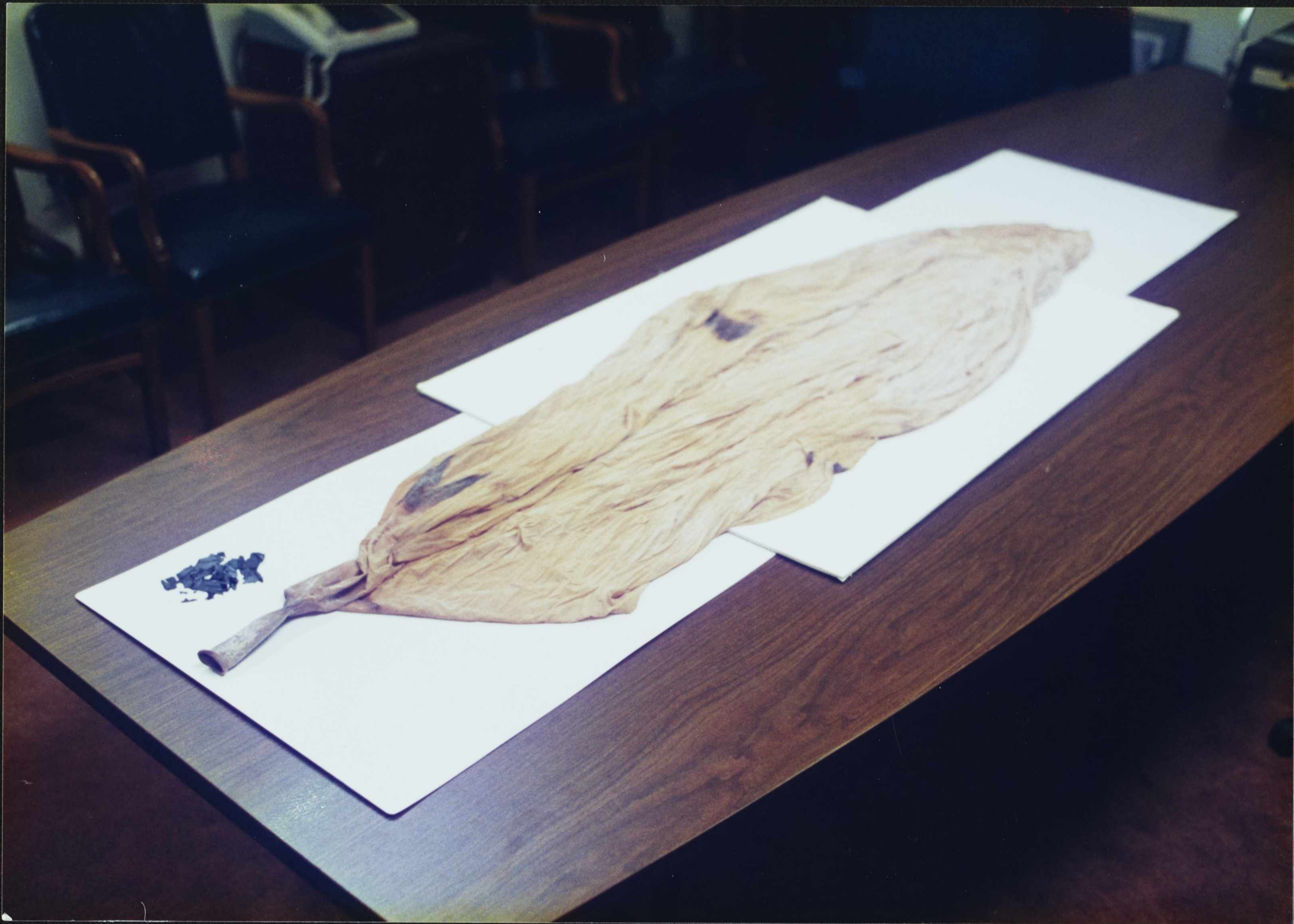
