OUR POSITION APRX 30 DEG LAT 101 DEG EAST LONG WE SIGHTED A
BLAZING LIGHT MOVING EAST OF OUR POSITION. IT WAS FIRST
SIGHTED AT 3 TO 5 DEG ABOVE THE HORIZON AND MOVED DOWNWARD
FOR APRX 30 SECONDS UNTIL IT DISSIPATED ABOUT 10 DEG BELOW
THE HORIZON. THE PHENOMINA SIGHTED BURNED WITH CHANGING
DEGREES OF ORANGE INTENSITY AND EXHIBITED ON A SHORT
FIRE TRAIL. IT LOOKED LIKE AN ACFT BURNING EXPLOSIVELY IN
LEVEL FLT. WE ALTERED OUR COURSE TO THE APPARENT POSITION
OF THE LIGHT AND SEARCHED THE TERRAIN WHERE WE BELIEVED
IT MIGHT HAVE BEEN OVER. NEGATIVE GROUND SIGHTING. REPORTED
