WAS THE SECOND QUOTE "FLYING SAUCER", UNQUOTE, THAT SHE HAS SEEN IN THE PAST 3 YRS. SHE STATED SHE SAW THE FIRST ONE WHILE AT A DRIVE-IN THEATER AND IT WAS IDENTICAL IN COLORING AND PERFORMANCE; HOWEVER, SHE STATED IT WAS CONSIDERABLY CLOSER TO HER DUE TO ITS TERRIFIC SIZE. SHE ESTD THE SIZE OF THE FIRST UFGC TO BE $1/3$ THE SIZE OF THE DRIVE-IN MOVIE SCREEN. THE CHILDREN WHO OBSERVED THIS REPT UFGC WERE EXTREMELY FRIGHTINED AND EXCITED BY THE SIGHTING. POSSIBILITY EXISTS THAT THE FALLING LIGHTS WERE FLARES DROPPED BY A COGARD ACFT DURING NIGHT-OPERATIONS TNG. WHILE THIS TYPE OF TNG IS PERIODICALLY CONDUCTED IN THIS AREA, LOCAL USCG OFFS STATED THEY WERE NOT AWARE OF ANY SUCH TNG BEING CONDUCTED AT THE TIME OF THE REPORTED SIGHTING.

10. BRIEF SUMMARY OF SIGHTING Round object with funny design descending in front of car at drive in movie. Object stopped, went slow to the right, stopped again and took off real crazy. Flat and round. Informed husband in same car that she had seen flying saucer. Screamed and attracted attention at the theater. Didn't report sighting because people would think she was crazy. Same object observed on 25 June through window of home. Time about 0300 local. Also noise with this sighting.	11. COMMENTS Strong possibilities of psychological causes, or at least distortions in report. Husband in same car did not report seeing object, and with slow movement of object valid sighting would include observation by him, as well as others in movie.	

First time we saw this thing was on Memorial Day at a Drive-In Theater (Sherwood) My husband and some friends that we visiting from Cleveland was a couple of cars over from me. Approximately 8:45-9:00. Coming straight down like a round object would go making a funny looking design as it came down. All at once it stopped and went slow to the right. Then it stopped. Then it took off real crazy and I told my husband that I saw a flying object. It was flat, and round. She said she screamed so loud that it attracted some attention at the Theater. She didn't report it because people would think she was crazy. Although she was frightened. She had heard a report that the Air Force was putting funny looking things into the sky, maybe for some new experiment. So she didn't think anything about that anymore until she read the paper and saw that article. She told a couple of friends and they laughed at her.

Then she saw something again last night. It went right across the window just like a great big something and she couldn't sleep very well. She has an upstair apartment. It was around 3 in the morning. An airplane couldn't come down that low. Made a type of noise like something passing real fast right across the window. Some friends said that they think the end of time is coming. Which I assured her it wasn't.
