REPORTED FLYING OBJECTS OVER MARRERO, LOUISIANA. APPEARED CIRCLING  
AREA OVER HUEY P. LONG BRIDGE AND MARRERO. NOT IN ANY FORMATION AND  
AT HIGH ALTITUDES. MOISANT AIRPORT RADAR DETECTED NEBULOUS TARGETS IN  
AREA. SEVERAL AIR NATIONAL GUARD AIRCRAFT IN AREA MAKING APPROACH  
RUNS TO MOISANT FROM VARIOUS VECTORS. OBSERVERS BELIEVE OBJECTS NOT  
AIRCRAFT. LIGHTS ON OBJECTS, ONE WHITE LIGHT AND ONE RED FLASHING  
ON AXIS WITH RED IN READ. STATED RED LIGHT APPEARS LIKE A SPARLERLER.
