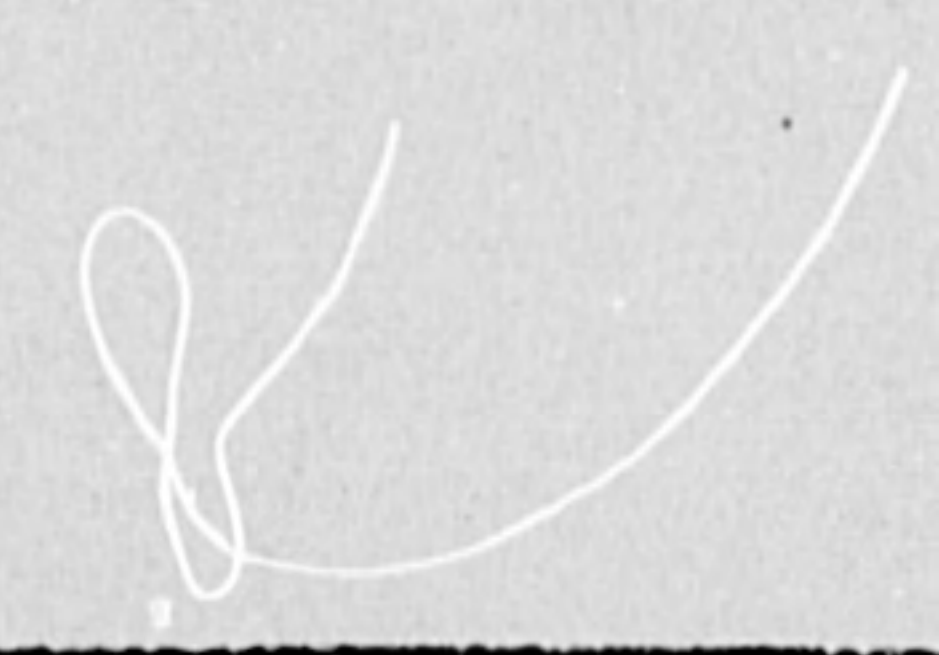

B. OBJECT FIRST SIGHTED AT GEOGRAPHIC REFERENCE HM 01 AND OBSERVED BY RADAR OPERATOR AND RADAR SGT, EACH WITH APPROXIMATELY 21 MONTHS EXPERIENCE ON THE RADAR.

C. OBJECT FADED FROM SCOPE AT GEOGRAPHIC REFERENCE HN 00 APPROXIMATELY 30 SECONDS AFTER INITIAL SIGHTING. WHEN LAST OBSERVED OBJECT WAS ON 185 DEGREE COURSE.

D. DISTANCE AT INITIAL PICK UP WAS APPROXIMATELY 70 NAUTICAL MILES. OBJECT FADED AT 80 NAUTICAL MILES. ESTIMATED SPEED APPROXIMATELY 1200 KNOTS.
