12 THE 689TH ACW SQDN HAD NW576 ADCS, INBOUND FROM HONOLULU TO PDX ON THEIR RADAR SCOPE, WHICH CORRELATED WITH THE A/C THE OBSERVER SAW AT THE TIME SHE SIGHTED THE OBJECT. THE A/C WAS ON A NE HEADING, WHILE THE OBJECT WAS ON A SE HEADING. THE PILOT OF THE A/C WAS CONTACTED, BUT REPORTED THAT HE SAW NOTHING.

THE OBSERVER ALSO REPORTED THAT WHEN SHE SAW THE OBJECT VISUALLY THERE APPEARED TO BE ONE LIGHT AT EACH END, WHILE WITH BINOCULARS THERE SEEMED TO BE 2 LIGHTS AT EACH END.
