Discription of object as follows. One (1) round shaped object, the size of an apple. Color white and red. Object was below tree top level. The observer first sighted it out of her living room window. Object remained in sight for five minutes at this position then shot straight up into the sky. Object was in sight another six minutes before disappearing. Weather condition was clear.
