LENGTH OF SIGHTING UNK. REPORTING AIRCRAFT WAS FLYING
AT 17,000 AT 37DEG NORTH 142 DEG 45 MINUTES WEST AT TIME OF SIGHTING
WHICH WAS 15/0453ZM UNCONFIRMED REPORT THAT A NORTHWEST
AIRLINE AIRCRAFT ALSO REPORTED SIGHTING THE LIGHT BUT NO FURTHER
INFO OR AIRCRAFT NUMBERS AVAILABLE.
