- A. OBSERVED FROM APPROXIMATELY 090 DEGREES TO 020 DEGREES MAGNETIC,
40 TO 20 DEGREES ABOVE THE HORIZON.
- B. DIRECTION: OBJECT TRAVELING SOUTH TO NORTH.
- C. SPEED: AS FAST OR FASTER THAN A F-104.
- D. ADDITIONAL DATA: WEATHER CLEAR, MOON NOT IN AREA VIEWED. COLOR
- BRILLIANT WHITE STEADY LIGHT. WHEN OBSERVED FIRST TIME IT WAS
APPROXIMATELY MAGNITUDE OF ECHO ONE AND AS IT FADED OUT IT SEEMED TO
APPROACH WITHIN 20 DEGREES OF THE HORIZON. IT THEN REAPPEARED
APPROXIMATELY 10 SECONDS LATER WITH A VERY BRILLIANT LIGHT APPROX-
IMATELY TEN TIMES THE MAGNITUDE OF ECHO ONE, THEN SHUT OFF ABRUPTLY
AFTER APPROXIMATELY 20 SECONDS. AGAIN IT REAPPEARED AS BRIGHT AS IT
WAS THE SECOND TIME REMAINING ON UNTIL IT DISAPPEARED IN THE NORTH.
THE TOTAL TIME OBSERVED WAS FROM 2 TO 3 MINUTES.
