Objt brighter than any star.		11. COMMENTS Objt moving with a/c and at elev of 50. Disappearing below horizon, same position in about 30 min. Star or planet would take about this time to set. Initial observation at 3500N elliptic. Disappearance coincided with setting of <i>Venus</i> on elliptic Mag -4.1. Case listed as astro sighting of Venus.
