I would like to inform you of what I saw on the date of Feb. 12, 1962. I was looking at the moon at approximately 4:17 P.M. with binoculars. When I saw a strange object fling between me and the moon. It was fling at a high altitude at a northern direction at a 85 degree angle. It was fling over Rolesville, N.C. near Raleigh.
