Position of aircraft was 1217N/1173W on heading of 282 degrees at time of sighting. Pilot reported seeing UFO on bearing of 020 degrees from aircraft and travelling in a northerly heading. Estimate object to be approximately 20 degrees above horizon at a distance of 500 to 600 miles and trailing a bright tail 30 to 35 miles long.
