AS PLANET JUPITER APPEARING ONE OF THEM RED AND GREEN LIGHLAND THE  
OTHER RED AND WHITE TILL DISAPPEARING IN THE LEST HORIZON AT 0306 GMT  
ISTANCE BETWEEN THEM WAS STEADY AFTER TWO MINUTES ANOTHER SATELITE  
SAME BRIGHTNESS WHITE COLOR OBSERVED FROM SW TO NE DIRECTION IN  
HIGH ALTITUDE PASSED EXACTLY ABOVE OUR SHIP WITH GREAT VELOCITY  
DISAPPEARED VERY CLOSE TO FLAR VEGA.
