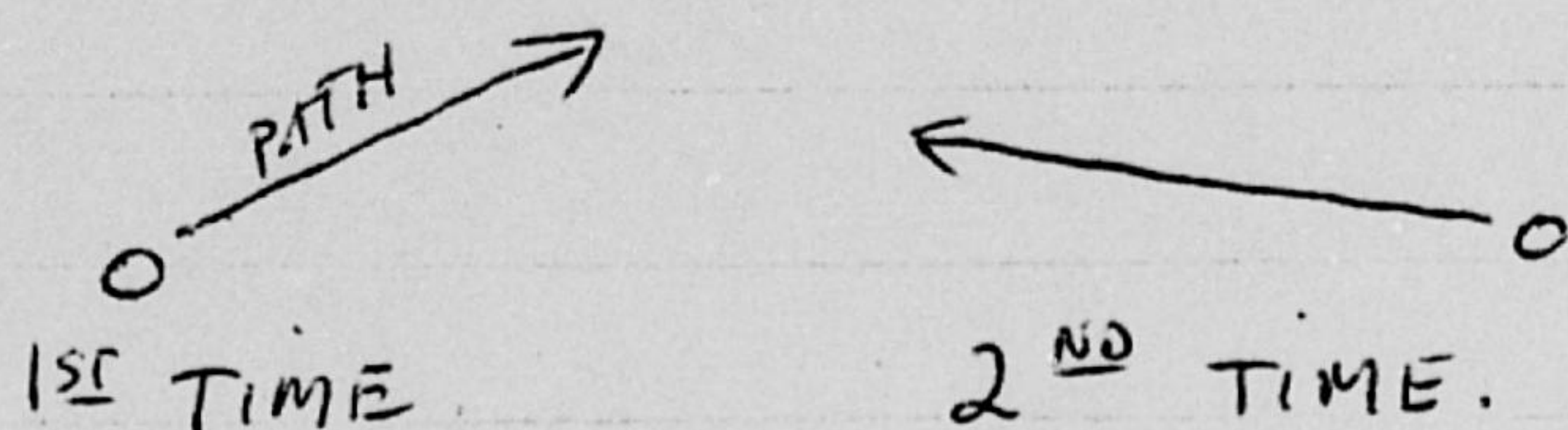

DEAR SIR,

ON THE MORNING OF MARCH 12, 1965
AT 4 A.M. NEW YORK TIME, A MOST

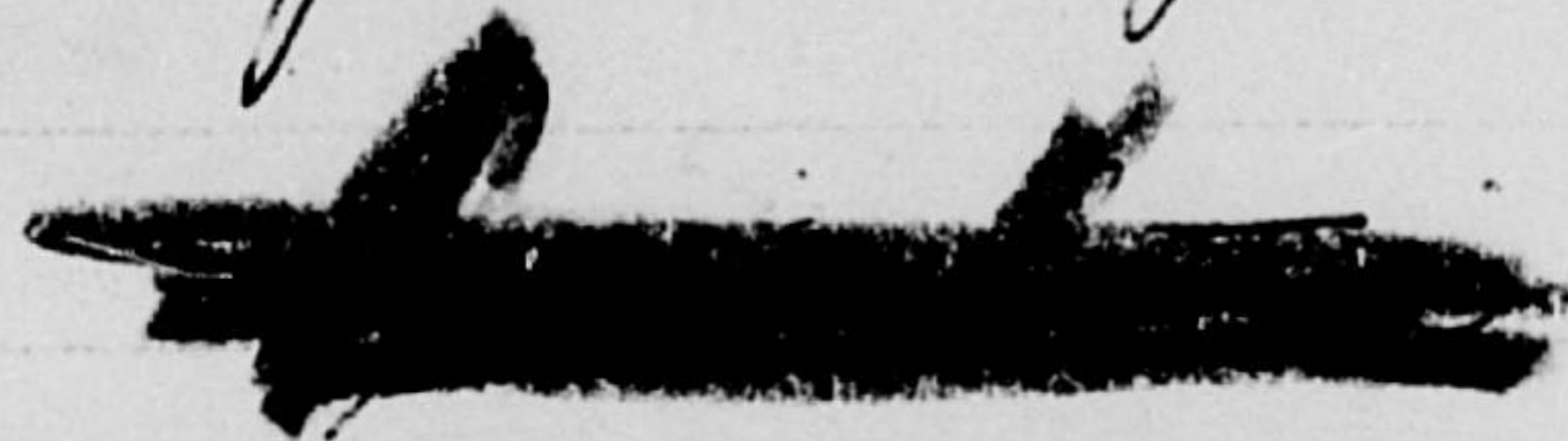

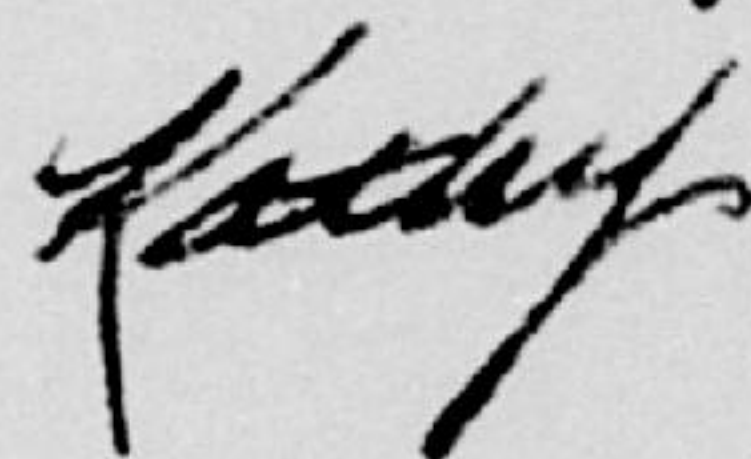
