- 22 Jul 65 At approximately 2030 - 2100 hours this date many calls were received from individuals also News Media concerning observations of UFO's. The general description, cigar shaped with red exhaust. The Weather Bureau, FAA, Allegheny Observatory and Bulhl Planatarium were contacted. The Observatory and Planatarium concluded that the objects sighted were Meteor Showers. News Media publicized same. As of this date, the News Media has given much publicity to UFO's.
- ? / 25 Jul 65 Several reports received from residents of the Pittsburgh area. General description, oval shaped orange disc's traveling in various directions.
- ? / 27 Jul 65 Several reports received from local residents. Orange sphere sighted 2130 - 2200 hours. Sphere rotated back and forth, stopped, then rotated and disappeared over the horizon, no flame, no noise, also reports of cigar shaped objects, same type reported 22 Jul 65.
- 1 Aug 65 Several reports received. Silver sphere object sighted. One report stated silver shaped saucer, small oval windows seen 1630 hours. Further questioning revealed report unreliable.
- 3 Aug 65 Report received of high pitched whine heard 0335 hours. However, individual saw nothing.
- 4 Aug 65 Report received of red haze in the sky 2140 hours, object sighted football in shape, no sound, about size of north star, disappeared over horizon.
- 7 Aug 65 Report received, red object sighted revolving as it traveled. Object brighter in the center, moving at a fast rate of speed.
- 11 Aug 65 Report received, round shaped bright orange object moving at a fast rate of speed, made a whistling sound, came down low and flew over residence. Also another report of flying saucer type object moving at a fast rate of speed. Further investigation revealed report unreliable.

SUMMARY: The inspecting officer has observed nothing to date. All reports are checked and most reports to our knowledge are unreliable and possible hoaxes. Publicity recently given UFO's we feel has stimulated telephone reports and because of the number of reports, forms have been reproduced for collecting initial information, which is checked further by the Information Officer at a later date. No releases by this organization concerning UFO's have been made to the news media. SAFOI has been contacted and the current report on Project Blue Book has been received. Names, addresses and phone numbers of observers reporting UFO's are kept on file. The FAA, Weather Bureau, other military installations in the area, Allegheny Observatory, Bulhl Planatarium have been informed to contact this organization when UFO's are sighted.
