The object was alone.

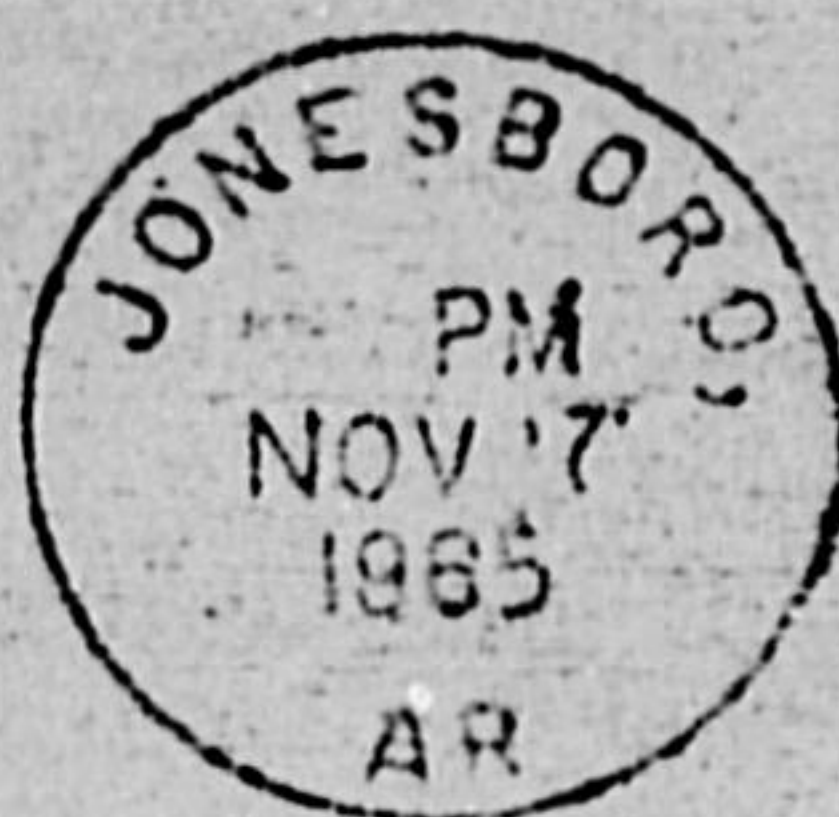
