1. MEMBER US EMBASSY RABAT REPORTED SIGHTING UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECT
30 JAN 66. REPORT AS FOLLOWS: THE PHENOMENON I OBSERVED WAS AT 1221
HOURS ON 30 JAN 1966 (IT WAS SO CURIOUS THAT I CAREFULLY NOTED THE
TIME AND POSITION IN CASE IT WAS REPORTED IN THE PRESS). IT WAS SEEN
IN THE SKY AT ABOUT FOUR FINGER'S ALTITUDE ABOVE THE HORIZON, AT
APPROXIMATELY 30 DEGREES ELEVATION, WITHIN FOUR OR FIVE MILES OF MY

FAINTLY VISIBLE, AND VERY LARGE IN RELATION TO THE HORIZON,
SUDDENLY APPROXIMATED AND PLUNGED VERY RAPIDLY TOWARD THE EARTH,
TRAVELING FROM RIGHT TO LEFT A FEW DEGREES OFF PERPENDICULAR. THE
PHENOMENON RESEMBLED DESCRIPTIONS OF A CELESTIAL OR MAN-MADE BODY
ENTERING THE ATMOSPHERE AND BURSTING UP, SINCE EVEN DURING THE VERY
BRIEF PERIOD IT WAS VISIBLE, THE BRIGHTNESS OF THE LIGHT VISIBLY
INCREASED IN INTENSITY UNTIL IT DISAPPEARED AS QUICKLY AS IT HAD
APPEARED.
