


I WAS WALKING BY THE FREEWAY PROJECTS WITH A FRIEND WHEN I HEARD A LOUD JET NOISE. IT WAS LOUDER THAN WE USUALLY HEAR AROUND THIS AREA AND I WAS SURPRISED. RUNNING TOWARD THE HIGHWAY CLIFF I LOOKED UP AND FOR ABOUT A SECOND I COULD SEE THE SHAPE OF A SMALL JET AIRCRAFT. LOCATING AHEAD OF AIRCRAFT, ISAW A BRIGHT LIGHT, SLIGHTLY LARGER THAN THE FARTHEST LANDING LIGHT ON THE AIRCRAFT. I AM POSITIVELY CERTAIN THAT THE JET WAS PUSHERING THE UFO.
