


I WAS WALKING BY THE FREEMAN PROPERTIES WITH MY FRIEND WHEN I HEARD A LOUD JET NOISE. IT WAS LOUDER THAN WE USUALLY HEAR AROUND THIS AREA AND I WAS SURPRISED. RUNNING TOWARD THE HIGHWAY CLIFF I LOOKED UP AND FOR ABOUT A SECOND I COULD SEE THE SHAPE OF A SMALL JET AIRCRAFT. LOOKING AHEAD OF AIRCRAFT, I SAW A BRIGHT LIGHT, SLIGHTLY LARGER THAN THE BRIGHTEST LANDING LIGHT ON THE AIRCRAFT. I AM POSITIVELY CERTAIN THAT THE JET WAS PURSUING THE UFO. ALL DURING THE FIGHTING THE LIGHT SEEMED TO STAY 30 OR 40 FEET AHEAD OF THE JET. THE LANDING LIGHTS OF THE JET WERE PERFECTLY CLEAR AT ALL TIMES, BUT LANDING LIGHTS ON LEAD OBJECT WERE NOT SEEN. WE EVEN SAW TWO DIFFERENT SHOTS TO BE SURE. THE LIGHTS WERE NOT JUST BACKED OUT BY RUDDER, BUT WE JUST COULDN'T FIND ANY OTHER LIGHTS ON THE UFO. IT WAS THIS FACT THAT MADE ME RULE THE POSSIBILITY OF A ROUTINE INTERCEPT PRACTICE. THE OPERATIONS OFFICER AT WRIGHT-PATTERSON SAID THEY HAD NO JETS OVER CLEVELAND, SO IT MAY HAVE BEEN A NATIONAL GUARD PLANE. THE OFFICER I SPoke TO FROM BLUE BOOK SAID HE THOUGHT IT WAS A SHUTTLE, BUT I HADN'T ASKED HIM WHEN I SAW HIM. I AM UNDER THE OPINION THAT A JET WAS SCRAMBLING TO CHASE A LEAD. I WOULD APPRECIATE IT IF YOU WOULD INFORM ME OF YOUR EXPLANATION.
