Several calls were received regarding a streak of fire in the sky about 1015 EST 6 Oct. 66. One observer reported that the fire seemed to be following an aircraft. Another reported only the fire was seen. One said that a parachute was seen.

Contact was made with the Base Operations WP AFB, Ohio at 1105 EST 6 Oct. 66. A F-111 took off from Patterson Field at 1006 EST 6 Oct. 66 and shortly thereafter kicked in his after-burner. They had received several calls regarding this incident also. They reported that an unusually large streak of fire was a result of his afterburner being kicked in.
