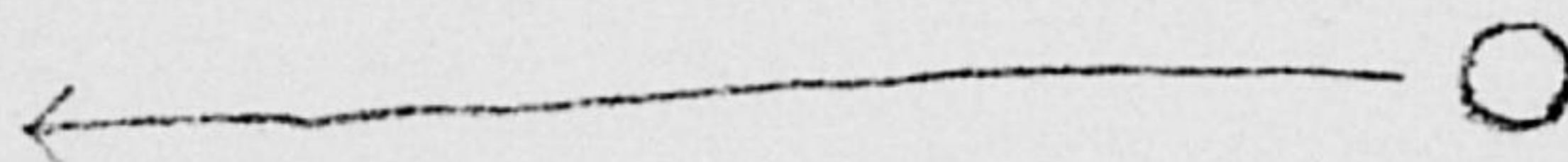

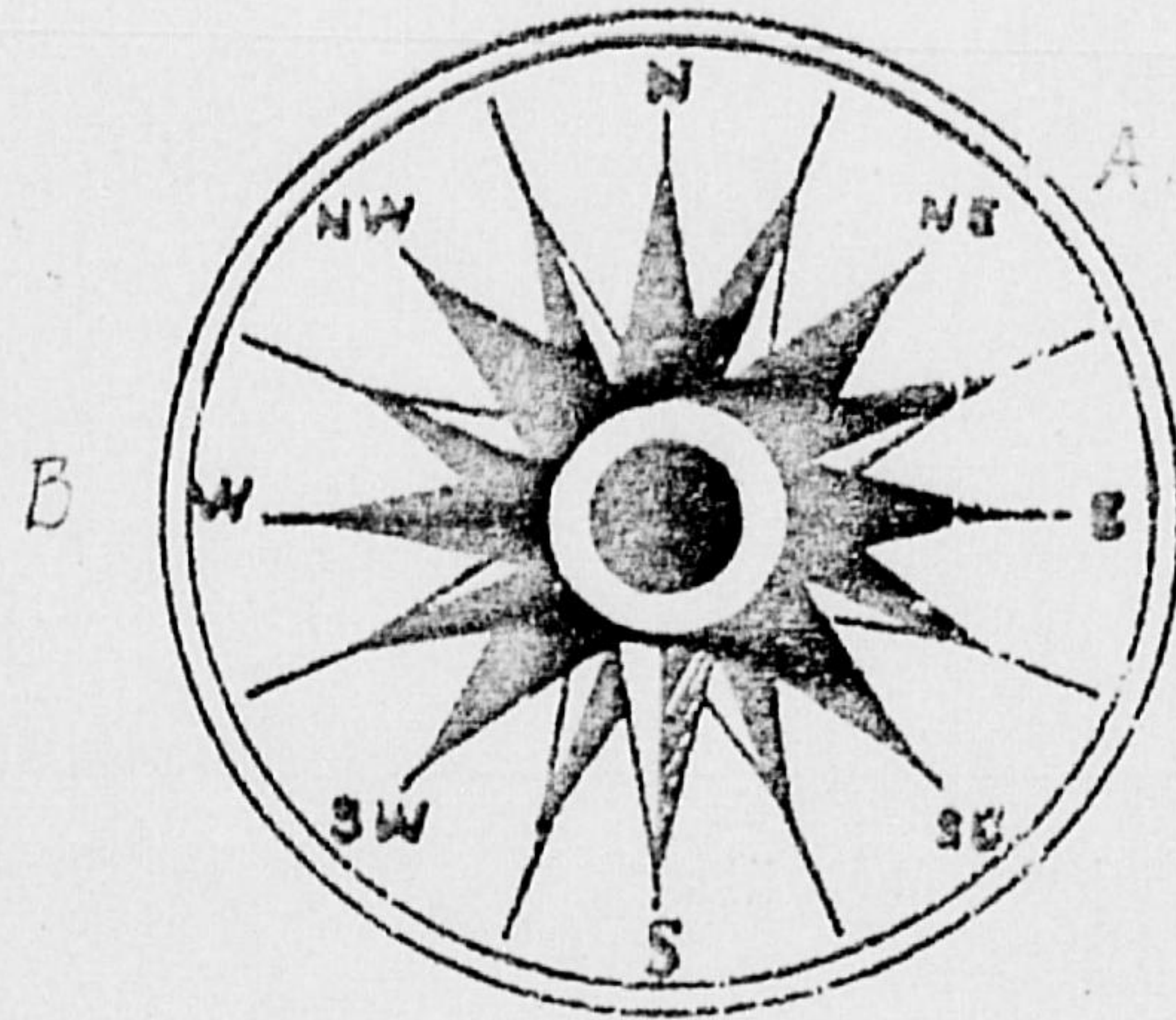
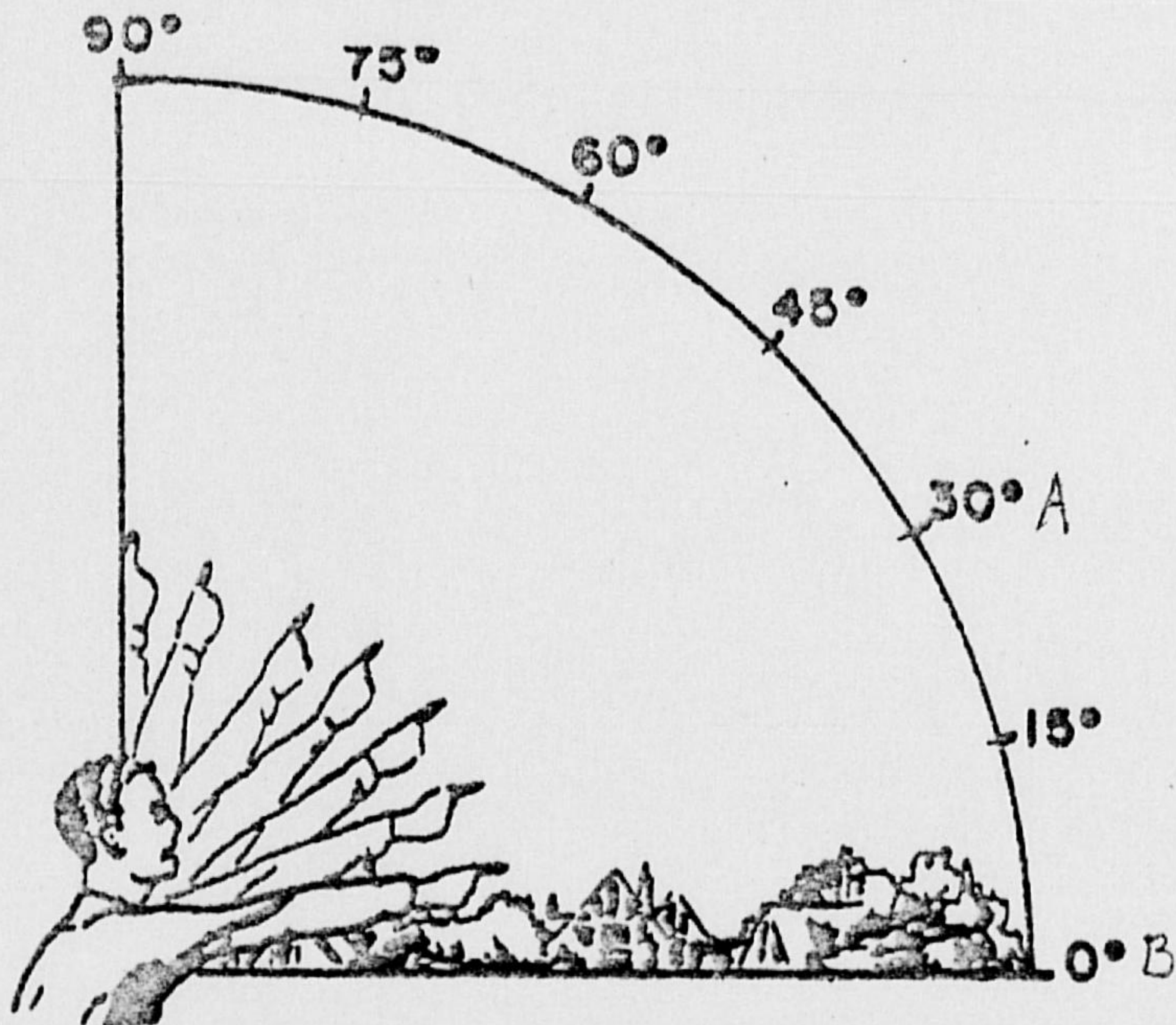

I saw two U2's on Wednesday night, January 25, 1966. The first one was sighted about 7:15 and it was silent and was moving at a fast pace. It headed in a westward direction and had 1 white light. I lost it and then I again saw it and it had stopped. It made a slow descent.

The second was sighted about 7:40 and made a fast descent. It had flashing lights, about 3 or 4.
