Reference your recent observation of an alleged unidentified flying object (UFO).

A study of the submitted information did not result in a positive identification. The red, green, and yellow-white lights are very consistent with that of an aircraft observation, especially since you did mention that a sound like a small aircraft was noted. Unusual aircraft lighting configurations have in the past been responsible for numerous UFO observations.

Thank you for reporting your observation to the Air Force. The latest edition of the report on Project Blue Book is inclosed.

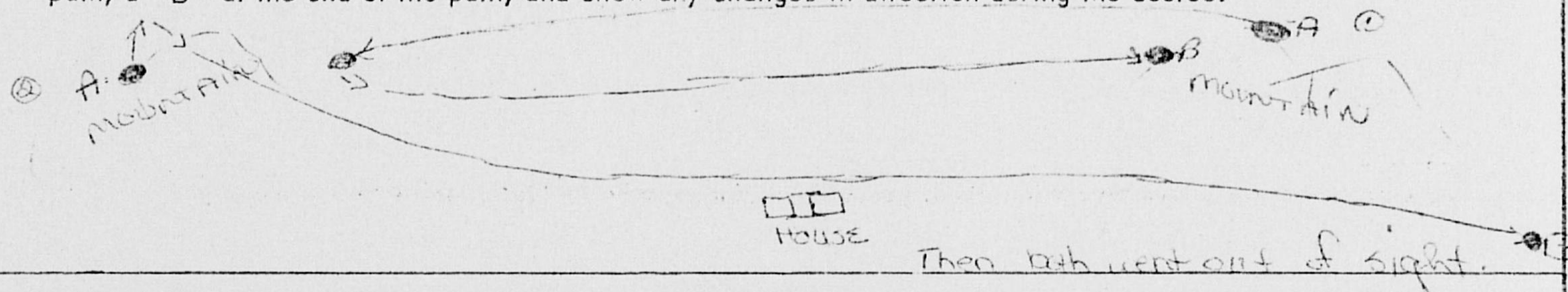

Information which you feel pertinent and which is not adequately covered in the specific points of the questionnaire or a narrative explanation of your sighting. *The first object that was the size of a basketball, stayed for some time in one spot before it seemed to roll across the sky and back again, and then disappeared. Then it disappeared, the object to the left of us, which had been in that spot for the same length of time, started to rise like a helicopter, then moved a short distance, and came over our front yard, just above the tree tops. We were standing by the front door and could clearly see the lights and silver base. The sound was that of a small plane but I maintain it was not a plane, nor a helicopter. And when it went over our heads, we soon got inside. It gave me a very weird feeling and I felt like "it" knew we were watching. Until that night, I thought anyone who had claimed to see UFO's had very good imaginations. But to me, what I saw that night was something out of the ordinary.*

The police in our township are five miles from us. I didn't think they would have time to get here so didn't call them. As it turned out, they had plenty of time. I did call the next day to see if they had any reports but they had none.

Dear Sirs:

On the suggestion of Mr. Frank Harney, who lives in Hackettstown, N.J., and was recently at the Pentagon. I am writing to you to describe what I have seen and hope you may have an explanation for it.

Two nights ago, January 30th, at six-fifteen my two daughters (8 & 16) and I watched for a period of maybe ten minutes a large, bright light that would turn a pale green, pale red, and then back to the bright yellowish-white color again. In another section, which would have been about opposite #1 light, was another light but soon after turned red and stayed that way. After about ten minutes of standing still, #1 rolled fairly fast toward #2 but got so far, and rolled back to the

be higher than the tree tops. As it
passed it was red - then yellowish-
white; like a two tone ball rolling
along. At that time I was in my
front yard and I raised up like
a helicopter, went forward and came
right over our front yard and that;
was just higher than the tree tops.
There were three lights on it - one red
one green, and one yellowish-white. It
was close enough that when I looked
up I could see a silver bar connects
the lights. I could hear a motor like
the sound of a small plane and I had
a feeling it was not a helicopter. I don't
know how they look at night but because
of the way it was lit, it didn't look
like one. Had it been a helicopter, would
not I have seen even a faint light where
the pilot sits? He saw nothing but the
three lights and the bar connecting
them. Where it went then, I don't know.
Because we were the only ones out or
having it come over. He gave me a

saw nothing for about forty-five minutes
and then off on the distance, we saw
two red lights going toward each other.
When they got close, one went over the
other and they just seemed to disappear.
I have talked to several people, including
the Mt. Olive Township police, but only
we saw something unusual. I know
imagination can take over but there were
three of us to see what we did and there
must be some explanation. There were several
places high up that night but those I know
were places. Having it come over our
yard has given me a weird and frightening
feeling. I have heard and read about U.F.
but I've never believed they existed. Now I
wonder! Did I or didn't I see something
unusual? Mr. Harvey suggested I ask for
your Blue Book on U.F.'s so I would appreciate
your sending it to me. And please, I am
telling you this after much hesitation but I
do not want it publicized. I was told you
would honor my request. I am
