10 minutes	Observer sighted an object that darted like a bird except it did not ^{appear to} have any wings. The object appeared as a bright steel blue bird and when first seen was hovering over the dog house. The object disappeared at tree top ^{level} height in the woods to the NNE.
6. TYPE OF OBSERVATION	COMMENTS: The observer states several times that the object looked similar to a bird except no wings could be seen. She further states that the object was just above the height of the house and was between 20 ft and $\frac{1}{4}$ mile away. She states that "I went on down the steps and to the end of the yard still watching what I thought was a new bird. It seems possible that the observer did actually see a bird under unusual conditions.




I had gone out the door to water a plant newly set out. Looked toward the north barn to see if cattle had come down to gate. Dog kennel is at immediate right across drive way. The object was over - or nearly over the house and attracted my attention by its metallic brightness. I thought at first it must be a tool reflecting the night light which was just coming on with the dusk. Twilight was still in the north western sky behind it.

It digged and darted like a bird, but there was no wing spread to support it. Moreover a bird would soon have been out of the reflective light and would appear as a dark object against the twilight. this thing kept its glinting brightness all the way to the woods the other end of the pasture.




It lost itself in the woodland or disappeared into the night at about tree top level in the wooded area north of the pasture.



I started out of the house to water some newly transplanted plants and paused on the steps a moment to look toward the north. It was just growing dusk and I was surprised by what I first saw to be a bright teal blue bird hovering over the dog house. I went on down the steps and to the end of the yard still watching what I thought was a new bird.

I emptied the water and returned watching it all the while. I realized that it couldn't be a bird. It stayed all this time over the dog house and gained only about five feet beyond it - and just above it. As I approached it continued on beyond it leisurely, uttering as though a partial rotation and glinting and brightening almost like a firefly would had it been that large and of this teal color. There was no sound and no wing motion - in fact no wing definition at all. It gradually disappeared into the gathering darkness and the woodland beyond. It reflected or glowed and darkened alternately well beyond the reach of our night light.

The dogs did not bark but they didn't want to come in out of the pen and they seemed to be quite excited.

Once before in 1963 I saw a similar and smaller object perform in nearly the same fashion while returning from work one winter night. This was late February or early March and driving about 9:30 at night on the wooded road an object floated in front of the car about mid vision drifted slowly to the right and off into the woods. It was an elongated pear shape and glowed constantly with only slight pulsation and with this same blue teal intense color. At the time I thought it might be some sort of electronic finding device that had been released

by the jets that sometimes come over. I was coming home from Washington and I did not pursue the matter because it was late and cold and I had work to do. This was about 2 miles from home,
