Dear Sir;

I am 8 years-old. I will be 9 in August. On December 12, 1967, I think I saw one of those "flying wings" that were seen down at Lubbock. Here is my story:

ON the night of December 12, 1967, at a little past 7:00 p.m., I was watching television. I heard a loud noise, it was going over my house. I thought it was a jet, so I went to the kitchen window (that faces the back yard of my house) and I looked out. I didn't see anything, so I went back into the den to watch television. My 1^{1/2} year-old brother, [redacted], was outside looking at the christmas lights. Suddenly, he came into the house saying, [redacted] "Come outside on the front porch and see this!" 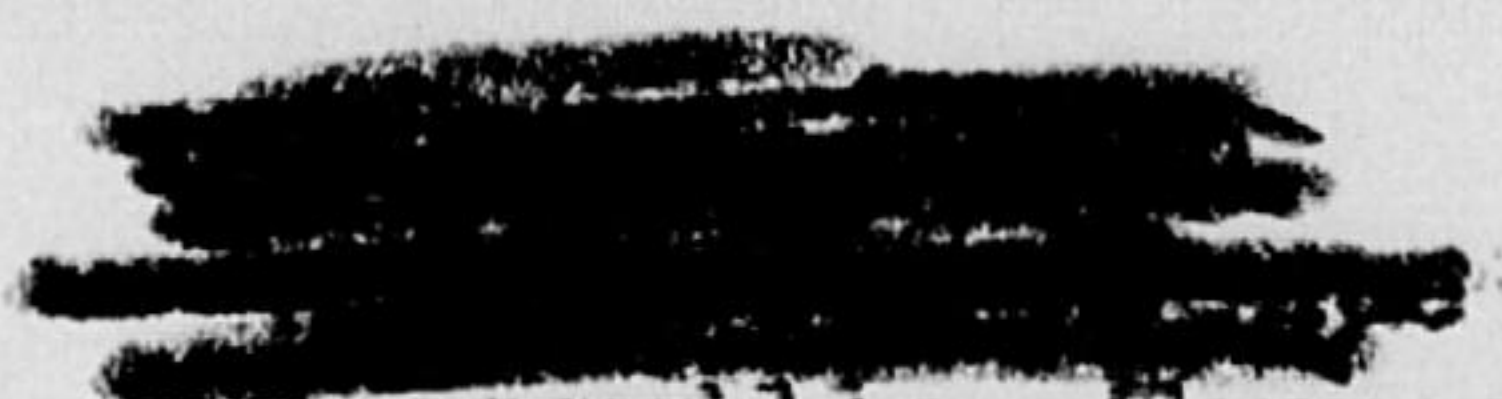
