Gentlemen:

On April 14, at 11:15 P. M. our family was about 5 Mi. NE. of Piqua, Ohio, on old route 25. The moon was very bright and we were observing it through 7X35 binoculars when our younger son Tom observed what he thought was a shootingstar.

Our entire family of 9 observed it by the naked eye and through binoculars. It was an object that moved through the sky at an azimuth of about 80 degrees. It was visible for several minutes. The fore part of it was glowing as if very hot. It left a wide long trail. It definitely was more than just a shooting star. It might have been a huge meteor. It was like a comet and at a very high altitude. However it was moving from west to east. It did not appear to be an aircraft.








Object appeared to have light red colored front. It seemed to be a rounded object. The back part seemed darker. My impression was that it was solid. It left a wide trail that was very long. The trail seemed to be about the same width and length all the time. The trail was much longer than it was wide. It was about 4 or five times longer than Saturn is on a bright night. It was at a very high altitude.

I have been informed that comets only move from east to west.



1. Reference your unidentified observation of 14 April 1968. We contacted the Space Detection Center at Ent AFB, Colorado, and they informed us that two pieces of satellite debris decayed at the approximate time of your observation.
2. Since the exact times of the decays are not known, we can only state that it is very likely that you observed one of the fragments decaying into the earth's atmosphere. Satellite reentry appears similar to that of a fireball except that the debris is much longer than a meteor observation. Satellite decay is usually whitish-blue in front and has an orangish-red fiery tail.
