





This will reply to your letter dated January 22, 1968, in which you recommended that orders be issued to shoot down any unidentified flying object (UFO) that would not communicate.

We must decline to follow your recommendation for a number of reasons. Of all sightings reported, the vast majority have been natural objects such as stars, meteors, satellites, and balloons; it would be infeasible to shoot down the first three categories, and no useful purpose would be served by shooting at the fourth category. In addition, small private planes are sometimes reported as UFO's; often these planes carry no radios, and if one were shot down, a senseless tragedy would result. Furthermore, no unidentified flying object reported, investigated, and evaluated by the Air Force has ever given any indication of threat to our national security.

Moreover, Mr. [REDACTED] the Air Force continues to extend an open invitation to anyone who feels that he possesses any evidence of extraterrestrial vehicles operating within the earth's space envelope to submit his evidence for analysis; so far, no one has done so.
