



Object was source of light which seemed to rotate every one-half second-very fast pulsation. Only bright, white light was visible-no other sign of running lights. When first seen-object was stationary and then started west and at approx. 6-800 miles per hour. No detail of shape could be seen-just the pulsating or rotating light-did not resemble any object in field of view. Object appeared as planet in brightness-as bright as Jupiter or moon(Jupiter was visible to the northwest of object-moon to the north.


