REMARKS

Aircraft reported an unidentified aerial phenomenon while E bound at FL350. The unknown phenomenon was bright lights orbiting at a high altitude in the vicinity of the Big Dipper constellation. The event was in the Northern Sky, possibly Canadian airspace. AWO notified.
