154159 A.C. - North American F-100C Super Sabre, first U.S. Air Force supersonic fighter to become operational is capable of "faster than sound" speed in level of climbing flight. Two versions, the F-100A and F-100C are now in operation, the former with the 479th Fighter Day Wing at George Air Force Base, California and the latter with the 322nd Fighter Day Group at Foster Air Force Base, Texas. The "C" model has provision for in flight refueling, can carry extra fuel drop tanks and bombs under the wings and has an improved method of accurately delivering bombs to a target. Both are powered by Pratt & Whitney J-57 axial turbo-jet engine with afterburner.
